

WHAT IS THE EBF?

The Economics and Business student Faculty association (EBF) is the faculty association for all students studying at the faculty of Economics and Business of the University of Groningen. The EBF organises a variety of formal and informal events to add value for students during their study time. The formal events help you to prepare for your future by bridging the gap between your studies and the business world. Next to that, the informal events focus on the social aspect of your studies. The EBF creates numerous opportunities to meet fellow students and to expand your network!

The EBF is the mother-association of four sub-associations. The EBF has a faculty wide focus, whereas the sub-associations focus on specific target groups within the faculty. These groups are described below.


LEADERSHIP PANELS

CAREER EVENTS

EBF/MARUG RECRUITMENT DAYS


EBF MEMBERSHIP VALUE CARD

- A: We noticed that study and a committee or ESR participation are difficult to combine for pre-master students in the first semester.
- Q: Does every pre-master have its own EBF Master Community?
- A: For pre-masters that are not served by a subassociation, the EBF offers a Master Community. See page 12!
- Q: Can I become an active member in my EBF Master Community?
- A: Once you finished your pre-master and start your master, you can become an active member in your EBF Master Community. During your pre-master, you can become active in one of the other EBF Committees recruited in February!
- Q: Are the EBF Events open to international students?
- A: The large majority of our events are completely in English, and are, therefore, open to international students. The language of the events are always indicated in the event description on our Facebook page.
- Q: Do I need to send in my CV when I sign up for events?
- A: For the vast majority of the EBF Events you need no knowledge on the topics that are discussed at all; the events are meant to be accessible to all FEB students unless otherwise indicated. Therefore, for most events, you do not need to send in your CV; just sign up and gain new experiences and insights!
